### AFFECTED CODE SECTIONS:

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**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:**

Section 811 of the County Charter requires that when the County budget shall have been finally adopted in the Annual Budget and Appropriations Ordinance, the Council shall thereupon by separate resolution levy and cause to raise the amount of taxes required by the budget in the manner provided by law so the budget shall be balanced as to proposed income and expenditures. In addition, Section 6-302 of Tax-Property Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, requires that on or before the following July each year, the County shall annually set the tax rate for the next taxable year on all assessments property subject to that county's property tax.

Accordingly, this Resolution will set the annual County tax rates for Fiscal Year 2021.
