ZONING BILL

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Signs

FOR the purpose of exempting temporary advertising signs on fast food restaurants from the requirement for a sign permit.

BY repealing and reenacting with amendments:

Sections 27-601(a), and

27-631,

The Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland,

being also

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

The Prince George's County Code

(1987 Edition, 1989 Supplement).

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for

that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Sections 27-601(a) and 27-631 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same are hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

PART 12. SIGNS.

DIVISION 2. ADMINISTRATION.

Subdivision 1. Permits.

Sec. 27-602. Signs exempt from sign permit.

(a) Types of signs exempt from sign permit, when all applicable Design Standards of Division 3, Subdivision 4, of this Part are met:

* * * * *

(2.1) Fast food restaurant temporary signs: A sign depicting an on-site sale or special event, made of cloth, canvas, plastic, or other light material, suspended from or fastened to a fast food restaurant for a short period of time.

DIVISION 3. DESIGN STANDARDS.

Subdivision 4. Signs Exempt from Sign Permit.

Sec. 27-631. [Reserved.] Fast food restaurant.

(a) Quantity

(1) Maximum number - 1 per each street frontage.

(b) Validity period

(1) The signs shall be removed as soon as torn or

damaged, and not later than sixty (60) days after erection.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) calendar days from the date of its adoption.
