The master plan area primarily focuses on Subregion 5, which is generally located between Andrews Air Force Base (to the north) and Charles County (to the south), and between the Potomac River, Gallahan Road, Old Fort Road, Allentown Road, Steed Road and Tinkers Creek (to the west), and Piscataway Creek, a PEPCO electric utility right-of-way and the Pope's Creek CONRAIL railroad (to the east).
