**REPORT:** Favorable, 5-0 In Favor: Council Members Davis, Dernoga, Hawkins, Streeter and Anderson-Walker.

The Government Operations and Fiscal Policy (GOFP) Committee convened on February 28, 2019, to consider the appointment of Jonathan Butler as Director for the Office of Central Services for Prince George's County.

Prior to joining Prince George's County, as the Acting Director, Mr. Butler was Chief Business Officer for the District of Columbia library, an independent agency of the District of Columbia Government. He was responsible for all operations related to business planning, finance, procurement, human resources along with other managerial responsibilities.

Mr. Butler has previous experience as Director of Contracts and Procurement with the District of Columbia Convention and Sports Authority, the District of Columbia Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, Data Computer Corporation of America, the District of Columbia Office of Contracting and Procurement and Lockheed Martin.

Mr. Butler has an undergraduate Degree from Virginia State University and a MBA from James Madison University. He holds membership in several prestigious organizations.

During the Committee meeting Mr. Butler candidly shared (his state) of the Office of Central Services and talked about the need for technology and manpower as well as his vision for the Office. This was greeted very warmly by Committee Members.

After a very brief but informative exchange, the GOFP Committee voted the appointment of Jonathan Butler out favorably, 5-0.
