The Education and Workforce Development Committee convened on March 9, 2026, to consider CR-013-2026, a Resolution concerning the Prince George's County Literacy Commission for the purpose of extending the deadlines for the submission of preliminary and final recommendations by the Literacy Commission and extending the Commission's initial term established by CR-088-2025.

This resolution extends the deadline for submission of the Commission's preliminary recommendations to the County Council from March 27, 2026 to September 30, 2026, extends the submission of the Commission's final recommendations to the County Council from June 2, 2026 to December 15, 2026, and extends the initial term of the Literacy Commission from June 3, 2026 to December 31, 2026.

The Policy Analysis and Fiscal Impact Statement noted that the enactment of this Resolution is not expected to have an anticipated fiscal impact on the County.

The Office of Law found the resolution to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.
