Loans to Safeway, Inc. ("Safeway") from the Maryland Economic Development Assistance Fund ("MEDAF") and Prince George's County, Maryland (the "County").

For the purpose of endorsing a loan not to exceed eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000) to Safeway from the Maryland Department of Commerce, formerly the Maryland Department of Business and Economic Development MEDAF program, which, in conjunction with the conditional loan from the County's Economic Development Incentive Fund ("EDI Fund") not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000), will be used for eligible project costs associated with a new facility in the County and capital expenditures.

WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of Commerce ("Commerce") and the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation ("EDC") have issued a joint proposal letter to Safeway dated February 23, 2016, outlining a non-binding expression of intent to offer incentives for its expansion project, copy attached as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, to provide a loan in an amount not to exceed eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000) ("the MEDAF Loan"); and

WHEREAS, the MEDAF Loan is authorized under the Maryland Economic Development Assistance Authority and Fund statute set forth in Sections 5-301 through 5-349 of the Economic Development Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the MEDAF Loan are expected to be used to reimburse Safeway for eligible costs in connection with the following activities: (1) capital expenditures related to an existing distribution facility in the County (the "Facility"); and (2) land purchase and costs of construction, furniture, fixtures and equipment costs; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the project costs will total approximately \$13.5 million which will be funded by: (1) the MEDAF Loan; (2) a conditional loan not to exceed eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000) (at least 10% match of the MEDAF Loan is required under Section 5-319(d)(2)(ii) of the Act), from the EDI Fund, (the "County Loan"); and (3) from private financing and the owner's equity for the remainder of the funds; and

WHEREAS, it is expected that the term of the MEDAF Loan will be six (6) years from the date of the disbursement, at an annual rate of three percent (3%) with payments of principal and accrued interest, which payments may be deferred or forgiven if Safeway employs at least six hundred twenty five (625) full-time permanent employees at the Facility for the term of the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, Safeway will employ at least six hundred twenty five (625) full-time permanent employees at the Facility by June 30, 2022; thereafter employing at least that amount at the Facility for the remaining term of the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, under Sections 5-319(d)(1) and (2)(ii) of the Act, a formal resolution of the governing body of the County is required to endorse the MEDAF Loan; and

WHEREAS, the County Council and the County Executive have determined, based upon the finding and determinations set forth herein, that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County that the County Council and the County Executive endorse the MEDAF and County Loans, as set forth in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Prince George's County Code Section 10-287, notice of intent to award financial assistance from the EDI Fund was provided to the County Council on June 20, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council and the County Executive of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the recitals in the WHEREAS clauses to this Resolution are hereby incorporated herein by reference and deemed a substantive part of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the loan from MEDAF to Safeway in an amount not to exceed eight hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$850,000) as set forth in Exhibit "A" or any revision thereof is hereby endorsed by the County Council and County Executive.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County's conditional loan to Safeway in an amount not to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) from the EDI Fund on substantially the

same terms and conditions of the MEDAF Loan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee are hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of the County such documents, instruments and certificates as are necessary or appropriate to consummate the MEDAF Loan and the County Loan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective as of the date of its adoption.
