## EMERGENCY BILL

AN EMERGENCY ACT concerning

Bonds to be Issued and Sold by The Maryland-National

Capital Park and Planning Commission

FOR the purpose of granting the Maryland-National Capital Park and

Planning Commission the approval of Prince George's County,

Maryland, to issue and sell Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) of its

bonds to provide funds for advance land acquisition in the County.

## RECITALS

The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission has authorized the issuance and sale of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) of its bonds pursuant to Section 7-106(e) of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, to provide funds for

the advance land acquisition revolving fund established by the Commission pursuant to Section 7-106(b) of Article 28 to be used to acquire land in Prince George's County, Maryland. Section 7-106(e) of Article 28 provides that the Commission must obtain the approval of the County before it may issue and sell such bonds.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission is hereby granted approval, as required by Section 7-106(e) of Article 28 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, as amended, to issue and sell Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) of its bonds, pursuant to the authority granted to the Commission by Section 7-106(e), to provide funds for the advance land acquisition revolving fund established by the Commission pursuant to Section 7-106(b) of Article 28 to be used to acquire land in Prince George's County, Maryland, which bonds have been authorized for issuance and sale by Resolution No. 89-34 of the Commission adopted on December 13, 1989.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that in accordance with the provisions of Section 317 of the Charter, the County Council hereby declares that a public emergency exists affecting the public health, safety and welfare; said emergency being the immediate need to provide funds for the capital projects and purposes described in this Act.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect on the day it becomes law.

Adopted this  $\underline{5th}$  day of  $\underline{June}$ , 1990, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the full County Council.
