SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
Maryland, that Section 18-141of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby		
added:		
SUBTITLE 18. POLICE.		
DIVISION 5. POLICE DEPARTMENT.		
Subdivision 1. Organization and Administration.		
Sec. 18-141. Video cameras and recording devices.		
(a) The Chief of Police shall provide for the installation of video cameras, and automati		
recording devices for each video camera installed, in all areas of Police Department facilities that		
are used for the interview or interrogation of witnesses and criminal suspects and for the		

processing of arrested persons. Video cameras shall be installed in a manner to eliminate to the extent possible areas that cannot be viewed by the camera.

(b) The Chief of Police shall establish and maintain written regulations in accordance with other legal requirements concerning the installation of video cameras and automatic recording devices designed to maximize the recording of all activities in areas where witnesses, criminal suspects, and arrested persons are in contact with members of the Police Department.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
