WHEREAS, t	the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, initiated a
Sectional Map Ame	endment to the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zones by the adoption
of CR-21-2014 on A	April 22, 2014; and
WHEREAS, t	he Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional Map Amendment
is proposed to amen	d the overlay zones established on September 27, 1988, and described in CR-
120-1987 and CR-4	-1988, respectively; and
WHEREAS, t	he Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone is located in portions of all
three river basins in	Prince George's County: the Anacostia, the Potomac and the Patuxent
Rivers; and	
WHEREAS, t	the purpose of the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional
Map Amendment is	to incorporate the requirements of House Bill 1253, being also Chapter 119
of the 2008 Laws of	Maryland, namely that local jurisdictions amend their Chesapeake Bay
Critical Area Overla	ay Zones for consistency with the current State-established boundaries; and
WHEREAS,	on June 12, 2014, and pursuant to Sections 27-213.08 and 27-213.10 of the
Zoning Ordinance o	of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince

George's County Code , the Prince George's Planning Board of the Maryland-National Capital

Park and Planning Commission held a duly advertised public hearing to consider the proposed Sectional Map Amendment and to take public testimony; and

WHEREAS, the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Map was officially transmitted to Prince George's County from the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Critical Area Commission on June 13, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 27-213.08(e) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, that the acceptance and processing of Zoning Map Amendment applications and Special Exceptions within the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone ceased until after final action by the District Council on the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional Map Amendment; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 2014, the Prince George's County Planning Board of The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission transmitted the Adopted Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional Map Amendment, as embodied in PGCPB No. 14-57, to the District Council; and

WHEREAS, on September 8, 2014, and pursuant to the provisions of Section 27-213.11 of the Zoning Ordinance, the District Council held a duly advertised public hearing to take testimony on the Adopted Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional Map Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the District Council finds that the proposed Sectional Map Amendment will update the Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone for the County, thereby replacing the Critical Area Overlay Zone approved by the Council on September 27, 1988, as described in resolutions CR-120-1987 and CR-4-1988, respectively; and

WHEREAS, the District Council further finds that the proposed Sectional Map Amendment meets all prescriptions set forth in Section 27-213.11 of the Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the 2014 Chesapeake Bay Critical Area Overlay Zone Sectional Map Amendment, as adopted by the Planning Board pursuant to

2	herein, be and the same is hereby approved.
