Committee Vote: Favorable as amended, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Dernoga, Turner, Dean, Harrison and Knotts)

Staff provided a summary of the resolution and referral comments that were received. CR-67-2009 encourages Prince George's County Departments and Agencies to provide for recycling opportunities at all County Sponsored events and activities.

The Committee adopted an amendment to include discussion on the Ten-Year Solid Waste Management Plan's recycling component. A representative of the Department of Environmental Resources indicated that recycling is already part of the Plan and the new information can be incorporated.

The Office of Law determined that CR-67-2009 was in proper legislative form.

The Office of Audits and Investigation indicated there will not be a negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-67-2009.
