SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-320 of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, be and the same is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:

### SUBTITLE 27. ZONING.

# PART 4. SPECIAL EXCEPTIONS.

### **DIVISION 1. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES.**

### Sec. 27-320. Effect of rezoning on approved Special Exception.

(a) When any land, or portion thereof, upon which a Special Exception has been approved is reclassified to a zoning category different from that category in which it was classified at the time the Special Exception was approved, the following shall apply:

\* \* \* \* \* \*

(6) If a Special Exception is approved for property owned by the State or Federal Government in the O-S Zone, the Special Exception shall remain valid upon placement of the property in the R-O-S Zone as a result of a conveyance of the property, and the Special Exception use shall remain applicable to the requirements of the O-S Zone.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Ordinance shall take effect fortyfive (45) calendar days after its adoption.
