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1 PROCEEDINGS 2 CHAIRMAN: Now moving onto our regular agenda 3 items. We have two of them. First is item 5, Detailed Site Plan DSP-23020, Central Industrial Park. We have Mr. 5 Haller, who is representing the applicant. We have Mr. 6 Cofield is going to be giving the staff presentation. I 7 don't think -- we actually do have a few folks signed up to 8 speak on this, I believe. 9 This is an evidentiary hearing, so if there are 10 folks who are going to be testifying, I will swear them in 11 at the appropriate time. And let's start off with staff. 12 Mr. Cofield? 13 MR. COFIELD: Good morning, Mr. Chairman, members 14 of the Planning Board. For the record, I'm Dexter Cofield 15 with Urban Design Section. 16 CHAIRMAN: Mr. Cofield, hold on one second. 17 just want to check. 18 Mr. Geraldo, can you hear him? 19 COMMISSIONER GERALDO: Yes. 20 CHAIRMAN: Okay. Good. Thank you, Mr. Cofield. 21 Keep going. 22 MR. COFIELD: Item number 5 is Detailed Site Plan 23 DSP-23020 Central Industrial Park, which requests a change

to the list of permitted uses for the subject property

within a light industrial zone development district overlay

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1 zone in order to allow a contractor's office and site 2 improvements to parking and pedestrian circulation. 3 Subject DSP does not propose any new structures on 4 the property. The site will be improved with one new bike 5 rack, construction of a pedestrian pathway, and seven 6 parking spaces. Please note, two citizens did sign up to 7 speak on this item. I have reached out to them and answered 8 any questions they had regarding the application. 9 With that, the Urban Design staff recommends that 10 the Planning Board adopt the findings of this report and 11 recommend to the District Council approval of the Detailed 12 Site Plan, DSP-23020 Central Industrial Park subject to the 13 conditions of approval with the Technical Staff report. 14 This concludes the staff presentation. Thank you. 15 CHAIRMAN: Thank you, Mr. Cofield. 16 Commissioners, unless there's any questions for 17 staff, we'll turn to Mr. Haller. 18 MR. HALLER: Good morning --19 CHAIRMAN: Good morning. 20 MR. HALLER: -- Mr. -- thank you very much. Good 21 morning, Mr. Chairman. Can you hear me this morning? 22 CHAIRMAN: Yes, sir. 23 COMMISSIONER WASHINGTON: Yes. 24 MR. HALLER: Great. Thank you once again. 25 Haller, I'm an attorney with offices here in Largo. And I'm

here on behalf of the applicant and owner of the property in this Detailed Site Plan application. I would like to thank Mr. Cofield for his assistance in working through this application with us. And we are in full agreement with the staff's recommendations and the recommended conditions.

This property has a somewhat tortured history, and I could keep you here all day listening to it, but I won't do that to you.

COMMISSIONER WASHINGTON: Thank you.

MR. HALLER: You have a short agenda. I do want to note that the owner of the property is American Resource Management Group, and the principal owner of that entity, Mr. Bob Bilo, who is also on today, is the owner of a company called DICO. DICO has been in business in Prince George's County since 1969. They are currently located in the Bladensburg area, and they bought this property to relocate their facilities here in 2020. However, because of subdivision and zoning issues, they have not yet been able to occupy the property.

DICO installs foundations. They install residential foundations, they install commercial foundations, they install custom foundations. And if your basement leaks, they also fix that, too. But they have installed over 60,000 residential foundations in Prince George's County since 1969. And so they want to stay in

1 Prince George's County. They bought this location to move 2 here. And it is perfect for their operations. 3 But they, because of the restrictions which exist, 4 have not been able to do that. The approval of this site 5 plan will allow them to now occupy the property, and they 6 are excited at the opportunity to be able to do that. 7 Again, I'm happy to answer any questions that you have 8 regarding the specifics of the request. But we do support staff's recommendation and the recommended conditions. 10 CHAIRMAN: Thank you, Mr. Haller. 11 Commissioners, any questions for the applicant at 12 this point? 13 COMMISSIONER WASHINGTON: 14 CHAIRMAN: No questions. Let me go to the sign up 15 list to see if we have folks signed up. I have a Danielle 16 Champion and a Khaalida Forbes. Either one of them here? 17 All right. 18 Then we have -- is there anyone else who wishes to 19 speak on this item? No? 20 Mr. Haller, I will give you the final word. 21 MR. HALLER: I am -- I am good, Mr. Chairman. 22 Thank you. 23 CHAIRMAN: All right. Thank you. 24 Then with that, Commissioners, I will close this 25 public hearing and turn to you all for any deliberation or
