SECTION 1. B	E IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,		
Maryland, that Section	n 10-106 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby		
repealed and reenacte	d with the following amendments:

	DIVISION 1. BUDGET AND AUDIT CONTROL.		
Sec. 10-106. Public	hearings; adoption of budget.		
(a) The Counci	l shall consider the proposed budget and set a time and place for two (2)		
public hearings. The	hearings shall be held not earlier than April 20 and not later than May 10.		
(b) After such l	nearings and any amendments as authorized by Section 814 of the Charter,		
the Council shall by o	ordinance adopt the budget for the forthcoming fiscal year, appropriate the		
amount of the expens	e items, and fix the rates of all special taxes. The number of permanent		
full-time and part-tim	e positions in the classified service, as enumerated in Section 10-105(b)		

and funded in the budget document for each agency or department, shall constitute the position authorization for those grade levels for that agency or department and shall not be exceeded unless approved in writing by a majority vote of the full Council.

(c) After the budget has been submitted to the Executive for his approval or item veto and returned to the Council, and after appropriate Council action has been taken on an Executive veto, if any, the Council shall set by resolution, the County general property tax levy. The levy shall be set forth in such a manner as to show the total property tax rate and that portion of the rate in dollars and cents per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Public Schools. Each County property tax bill shall show in [dollars and cents] percentage terms the amount of the County Government's portion of each tax bill that is attributable to the budget for Prince George's County Public Schools. Each tax bill shall also show the total County funding for the Prince George's County Public Schools and the total anticipated County revenue from property taxes for the current fiscal year.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
