**REPORT:** Favorable 4-0: Council Members Burroughs, Franklin, Ivey, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on September 8, 2022, to consider CB-089-2022. CB-028-2022 will increase the administrative leave hours allowed for County employees who volunteer in schools from twenty (20) to thirty (30) hours to support the school students in remediation and recovery activities, particularly in reading and mathematics.

Committee members expressed an interest in learning the number of employees who take advantage of this program and whether there is a specific time code to track such hours.

The Office of Law reports CB-089-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its enactment.

The Policy group reports that the adoption of CB-089-2022 will not have a direct fiscal impact.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported CB-089-2022 out favorably 4-0.
