**BILL**

1 AN ACT concerning

2 The Classification Plan for Prince George's County

3 For the purpose of assigning a certain class of work to the bargaining unit represented by the  
4 International Association of Fire Fighters Local, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Fire Fighters,  
5 Paramedics and Emergency Response Technicians).

6 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County  
7 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has in order to  
8 provide better governmental services, recommended to the Prince George's County Council an  
9 amendment to the Classification Plan for Prince George's County, Maryland which would add a  
10 certain class of work described in Section 1 of this bill; and

11 WHEREAS, the County Executive, pursuant to Section 903 of the Prince George's County  
12 Charter and Section 16-125(a) of Subtitle 16 of the Prince George's County Code, has  
13 recommended to the Prince George's County Council an amendment to the Classification Plan  
14 for Prince George's County, Maryland with respect to the class of work described in Section 1 of  
15 this bill, as provided in Prince George's County Public Employee Relations Board (PERB) Case  
16 Number 16 390 00157 95 and pursuant to the Collective Bargaining Agreement between Prince  
17 George's County, Maryland and the International Association of Firefighters, Local 1619 (Fire  
18 Fighters, Paramedics and Emergency Response Technicians) now, therefore,

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,  
20 Maryland, that the Classification Plan for Prince George's County be and the same is hereby

1 amended as provided in PERB Case Number 16 390 00157 95 and pursuant to the  
2 aforementioned collective bargaining agreement as follows:

8 calendar days after it becomes law and shall be retroactive
