Brief Summary of the Bill/Resolution:

CB-006-2026 would restrict immigration enforcement access to designated areas within County-owned and County-leased facilities. The bill would also require the County Executive to issue formal guidance outlining procedures for immigration enforcement actions at County facilities and to develop standardized signage templates for optional use by private entities. The bill proposes to prohibit or strictly limit the use of County properties by ICE and related agencies for the purposes of assembly or prosecution of activities aimed at the identification, detainment, interrogation, arrest, or harassment of individuals suspected of being illegal immigrants, or perpetrators of violation of Federal Immigration statutes.

The Land Acquisition and Real Property (LARP) Division manages the County's real estate portfolio, including acquisitions, dispositions, leasing, and inventory of County-owned and County-leased properties. The proposed legislation presents the following operational considerations:

1. Lease Administration

- Coordination with the Office of Law may be required to address enforcement regulations, if necessary.

2. Signage Implementation

- Coordination may be required to determine which County-owned and County-leased properties require standardized signage.
- Installation and compliance monitoring may have minor fiscal and administrative impacts.

3. Transactional Considerations

- Real estate transactions may require disclosure of County facility access policies.
- Additional due diligence may be necessary during acquisitions and public-private partnerships.

Fiscal Impact: /SB

OCS anticipated fiscal impact would be minimal, consisting of the expense to produce and install signage at County properties to inform the public and law enforcement agencies of the limitations of immigration enforcement activities, to include planning, staging, or execution of those activities. Expense is estimated to cost \$10,000 to purchase and install signage.
