COMMITTEE VOTE: Favorable 4-0 (In Favor: Council Members Exum, Harrison, Dean, and Turner)

This bill will approve the Lease Financing Agreement for the lease/purchase of snow removal equipment for use by the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Office of Central Service and ambulances for use by Fire/EMS Department. The items to be purchased are 45 pieces of snow removal equipment at an estimated cost of \$5,006,000 and 15 Fire/EMS Ambulances at an estimated cost of \$3,000,000.

Attachment A of the legislation contains a five (5) year lease (FY20011 – FY2016) financing agreement between the County and Grant Capital Management, Inc. (GCM) in which GCM will purchase the snow removal equipment and Fire/EMS Ambulances then lease with the option to purchase, the equipment and vehicles to the County. The total amount to be financed is \$8,006,000 at the interest rate of 2.48%. The initial payment on the principal is due April 1, 2011 in the amount of \$756,936 plus interest of \$99,274 which will make the total amount \$856,210.

The Office of Law has reviewed this bill and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The enactment of CB-89-2010 will have a negative fiscal impact on the County from FY2011 – FY2016. The total amount to be paid over the five (5) year payment period is \$8,562,100
