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**REPORT:** Favorable 4-0: Council Members Burroughs, Franklin, Ivey, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on September 8, 2022, to consider CR-101-2022. CR-101-2022 is a Resolution and Salary Schedule which accompanies CB-083-2022. This Salary Schedule reflects the modifications in the Agreement between the County and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics). Although the Agreement carries forward many of the terms and conditions of the County's previous labor agreement with the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1619, AFL-CIO (Fire Fighters, Paramedics and Fire Fighter/Medics), the new Agreement contains modifications that are listed for the Council in the enclosed ("Settlement Summary") for the Agreement.

Employees covered by this Agreement will receive merit and cost-of-living adjustments for FY'23 and FY'24.

The Office of Law reports CR-101-2022 to be in proper legislative form with no impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that CR-101-2022 will require additional expenditures of \$18 million over fiscal years 2023 and 2024.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported CR-101-2022 out favorably 4-0.
