1 (b) This Section shall not apply to County officials, officers, employees, boards, 2 commissions or agencies while acting in the performance of their official duties. 3 (c) If the penalty for a particular offense is limited by State Statute then such limitation 4 shall be applicable to the provision of this Code not withstanding the provisions of the 5 Section. 6 (d The suspension or revocation of any license, certificate or other privilege conferred by 7 the County, shall not be regarded as a penalty for the purposes of this Code but shall be in 8 addition thereto. 9 10 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby 11 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, 12 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of 13 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining 14 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this 15 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, 16 17 or section. 18 SECTION3.
