State of Maryland Community Investment Tax Credit Program For the purpose of approving the project submitted by Jehovah Jireh Community Development Center, Inc. ("JJCDC") to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Department's Community Investment Tax Credit Program.

WHEREAS, Section 6-401 through Section 6-406 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, established the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in priority funding areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-404 of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides for the allocation of tax credits to business entities that contribute to approved projects of nonprofit organizations that provide services to priority funding areas; and

WHEREAS, Section 6-405(c) of the Housing and Community Development Article, Annotated Code of Maryland, provides that the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development may not approve a proposal for participation in the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program unless the proposal is approved by the governing body of the county that includes any of the Priority Funding Area that benefits from the project; and

WHEREAS, JJCDC, a nonprofit organization, proposes to undertake the "Teens Take Charge – Educational and Self Esteem Program" project as more particularly described in Attachment A (the "Project"); and
