RE: County Resolution Concerning Stop Sign Monitoring by Municipalities

Dear Council Member Dernoga and Council Member Olson,

The City of College Park notes that resolutions for several municipalities in the County were presented at the May 27, 2025, County Council meeting. The City is also seeking to install Stop Sign Monitoring Systems at five locations in the City's corporate boundaries.

Please advise us of the necessary steps to have a resolution sponsored by one or both of you on the next available County Council meeting agenda.

The Mayor and City of Council of the City of College Park have taken several actions in support of this process. During the month of September 2024, a pilot study was conducted to determine best locations for these devices. Ordinance 25-O-02 was introduced on April 8, 2025, and a Public Hearing was held on May 13, 2025. The Ordinance was adopted on May 13, 2025, and will become effective June 03, 2025.

We are providing copies of supporting documents and seek your favorable response in support of a resolution.
