Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In Favor: Council Members Dernoga, Harrison Hawkins, Ivey, and Olson)

The Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee met on July 15 to consider two appointments to the Redevelopment Authority Board for Prince George's County. The County Council established the Redevelopment Authority Board with the enactment of CB-85-1997. The Board aims to stimulate revitalization in the County's older communities by acquiring land and property within Prince George's County for residential, commercial, or industrial development or redevelopment of these communities.

Ms. Alicia A. Doney and Ms. Michelle L. Rice are residents of Upper Marlboro and have previously served as appointees to the Redevelopment Authority Board.

Ms. Doney could not attend the Committee work session because of a scheduling conflict. Ms. Rice introduced herself, provided brief biographical information, and discussed her participation, membership role, and willingness to continue serving as a board member.

The terms for Ms. Doney and Ms. Rice will expire on July 28, 2027.

The Planning, Housing, and Economic Development Committee voted favorably, 5-0, in favorably on the appointments to the Redevelopment Authority.
