Neighborhood Partnership Program -

Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation For the purpose of approving a project submitted by the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Neighborhood Partnership Program.

WHEREAS, Article 83B, Section 4-701 through 4-706 of the Maryland Annotated Code established the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program, which includes the Neighborhood Partnership Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, Article 83B, Section 4-705(c) of the Maryland Annotated Code provides that the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) may not approve a proposal for participation in the Neighborhood Partnership Program unless the proposal is approved by the governing body of the county in which the designated revitalization area benefited by the project is located; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation (EDC), a nonprofit organization, proposes a comprehensive Inner Beltway Revitalization Project with three components for revitalization, development, and business expansion in Prince George's County (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, EDC proposes the sale of Neighborhood Partnership Program tax credits for the Project, which includes a component for the Commercial Area Revitalization Effort Program (CARE), designed to promote the economic vitality of Prince George's County's older

neighborhood commercial areas, by augmenting funding for Operation FACELIFT (facade/renovation), a security grant and market studies, and the architectural component of CARE, more fully described in Attachment A, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, EDC proposes, as another component to the Project, the sale of Neighborhood Partnership Program tax credits for the Community Development Corporation Capacity Building Initiative, which is designed for the development and implementation of a capacity building training academy for Prince George's County community development corporations, by funding community development corporation training and conference components of the Community Development Corporation Capacity Building Initiative, more fully described in Attachment B, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, EDC proposes, as the third component to the Project, the sale of Neighborhood Partnership Program tax credits for the Prince George's County Libraries Small Business Information Centers, which will establish and maintain small business information centers in five of the largest libraries in Prince George's County, by augmenting funding for the purchase of computers, software, print resources, equipment and directional signage components of the Prince George's County Libraries Small Business Information Centers Program, more fully described in Attachment C, attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, EDC has applied to DHCD for approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the Project, under DHCD's Neighborhood Partnership Program; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive expresses approval of the Project and an allocation of tax credits for business entities that contribute to the Project, under DHCD's Neighborhood Partnership Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the recitals to this Resolution are hereby incorporated by reference herein and deemed a substantive part of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Inner Beltway Revitalization Project submitted by the Prince George's County Economic Development Corporation to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for participation in the Neighborhood Partnership Program is hereby approved.
