BILL

1 AN ACT concerning

2 National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive Program Match

3 For the purpose of establishing an enhanced incentive program to encourage National Board-
4 Certified mathematics, science, and exceptional needs teachers to teach at low performing
5 schools in Prince George’s County.

6 BY adding:

7 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince George's County,
12 Maryland, that Section 10-365 of the Prince George's County Code be and the same is hereby
13 added:

14 SUBTITLE 10. FINANCE AND TAXATION.

15 **DIVISION 37. NATIONAL BOARD-CERTIFIED TEACHER INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

16 **MATCH.**

17 **Sec. 10-365. Prince George’s County National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive Program**

18 **Match.**

19 (a) Establishment of the Program. The Prince George's County National Board Certified
20 (“NBC”) Teacher Incentive Program Match shall:

21 (1) encourage teachers who are National Board Certified teachers to teach at public

1 schools in Prince George’s County and encourage NBC teachers to work at schools that are
 2 classified as low-performing, based on official Maryland State and Prince George’s County
 3 Public Schools classification and identification systems, thus increasing the incentive for NBC
 4 teachers, who by nature of their NBC status, have the highest nationally recognized teacher-
 5 specific certification, to teach at those schools;

6 (2) increase the incentive established by the State of Maryland’s Blueprint for
 7 Maryland’s Future Program for NBC teachers who teach at schools that are classified as low-
 8 performing based on official Maryland State and Prince George’s County Public Schools
 9 classification and identification systems, creating based on current available data, the largest
 10 incentive program tied to NBC teachers in the State, in recognition that there is a high need for
 11 NBC teachers to be employed at the forty-nine (49) schools classified as among the lowest
 12 performing in the State based on the Maryland State Department of Education 2025 NBCT List
 13 of Low-Performance Schools;

14 (3) encourage non-NBC teachers at schools deemed low performing based on official
 15 Maryland State and Prince George’s County Public Schools classification and identification
 16 systems to achieve NBC status, thus helping them enhance their teaching skills as well as
 17 achieve the highest nationally recognized teacher-specific certification; and

18 (4) supporting academic achievement of Prince George’s County Public School
 19 students by nature of their teaching expertise as ascribed to them by their National Board-
 20 Certified Teacher status, and thus contributing to the success of school communities with
 21 neighborhood schools having increased amounts of teachers with the highest nationally
 22 recognized teacher-specific certification, which can be a socio-economic driver affecting all
 23 County residents.

24 (b) Definitions. In this Division, the following words shall have the following meanings:

25 (1) **National Board Certification or (“NBC”)** means a nationwide certification
 26 program designed to recognize accomplished teachers and to generate ongoing improvement in
 27 schools issued by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards.

28 (2) **National Board Certified Teacher Incentive Program** means the incentive
 29 program prescribed in Section 6-1009, Education Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

30 (3) **NBC** teacher means a teacher who holds an active National Board Certification.

31 (4) **Prince George’s County National Board Certified Teacher Incentive**

1 **Program Match Fund** is a restricted nonlapsing fund administered by the Director of Finance
2 used solely to fund the Prince George’s County National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive
3 Program Match.

4 (5) **Teacher** has the meaning set forth in Section 6-1001(e), Education Article,
5 Annotated Code of Maryland.

6 (c) Prince George’s County National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive Program Match.
7 Subject to the allocation of funding in the annual County budget and/or other sources, including
8 but not limited to, funding for the bonus or stipend that may be issued through the State, Prince
9 George’s County Public Schools, Board of Education or the County, every NBC teacher who
10 qualifies for the incentive prescribed in Section 6-1009(A)(1)(II), Education Article, Annotated
11 Code of Maryland, for teaching at a low performing school in Prince George’s County and is
12 national board-certified in mathematics, science, or exceptional needs shall receive an annual
13 disbursement of \$7000 from the Prince George’s County National Board Certified Teacher
14 Incentive Program Match Fund. The duration of eligibility for this incentive disbursement shall
15 be the same as the duration of eligibility for the incentive prescribed in Section 6-1009(A)(1)(II),
16 Education Article, Annotated Code of Maryland.

17 (d) Administration. The Director of Finance shall establish and administer the process for
18 teachers to apply for and, if eligible and subject to the annual allocation of funding to the fund,
19 receive the Prince George’s County National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive Program Match.

20 (e) Reporting. By September 30 of each year, the Director of Finance shall provide an
21 annual written summary to the County Executive and County Council on the disbursements from
22 the Prince George’s County National Board Certified Teacher Incentive Program Match Fund for
23 the previous fiscal year, including the number of NBC teachers awarded the incentive and
24 amounts of fund disbursements, both in totality and on a school-by-school basis.

25 * * * * *

26 SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby
27 declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph,
28 sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of
29 competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining
30 words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this
31 Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such

1 invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection,
2 or section.

3 SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the County Council strongly urges and
4 intends to seek that the Prince George’s County Public Schools contributes funding to the Prince
5 George’s County National Board-Certified Teacher Incentive Program Match Fund, as well as
6 urges other state, federal, and private sector partners to contribute as well. The County
7 particularly expresses the intent to request \$1,000,000 for the fund from the Maryland General
8 Assembly in its Fiscal Year 2027 state budget.

9 SECTION 4. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45)
10 calendar days after it becomes law.
