REPORT: Committee Vote: Favorable 5-0 (Council Members Watson, Blegay, Burroughs, Dernoga, and Oriadha)

The Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee convened on September 11, 2025, to consider the appointment of the Director of The Office of Procurement, Ms. Alice Williams. The Director of The Office of Procurement shall be responsible for the administration of County laws relating to procurement, supplier diversity, and administering such procurement-related services as may be required by law. These services shall include, but need not be limited to:

- (1) Procurement;
- (2) Contract compliance;
- (3) Supplier Development and Diversity;
- (4) County Procurement Training and Certification; and
- (5) Purchasing Card Administration.

Ms. Dannielle Hunter, Appointments Liaison, Office of the County Executive, described Ms. Williams's background. The Acting Director brings over 38 years of experience spanning the full spectrum of federal procurement, including work as Acting and Deputy Director in a Senior Executive Service (SES) capacity. She oversaw a \$190 billion procurement portfolio and a 700-person workforce.

Ms. Williams shared some of her experiences over her years of service in the Federal government and thanked the County Executive for her nomination and trust.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council's Government Operations and Fiscal Policy Committee reported favorably on Ms. Alice Williams' appointment as the County's Director of the Office of Procurement, 5-0.
