A RESOLUTION concerning

Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program - 1997 Applications

For the purpose of approving proposals submitted to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of the proposed project and allocation of tax credits under the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly established at Article 83B, Sections 4-701, et. seq. the Neighborhood and Community Assistance Program to assist nonprofit organizations in carrying out approved projects in designated revitalization areas, to encourage businesses to invest in designated revitalization areas, and to strengthen public-private partnerships; and

WHEREAS, eligible nonprofit organizations may apply to the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development for approval of a project and an allocation of tax credits in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 per project for business entities that contribute to the project; and

WHEREAS, five proposed projects and requests for allocations of tax credits for 1997 have been submitted to the County Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, World Arts Focus, Inc./ Joe's Movement Emporium, 3802 34th Street, Mt. Rainier, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the Mt. Rainier area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, The Training Source, 1466 Addison Road South, Capital Heights, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the Capital Heights area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the University of Maryland - College Park, 3103 Turner Hall, College Park, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the College Park area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the National Phlebotomy Association, 5615 Landover Road, Hyattsville, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$10,000 to serve a project in the Cheverly area and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, The Prince George's County Housing Development Corporation, 9440 Pennsylvania Avenue, Upper Marlboro, Maryland, has requested a tax credit allocation of \$50,000 to serve a project in the Fairmount Heights, Capital Heights, District Heights, Seat Pleasant, and Cheverly areas and the County Council has reviewed and approves the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has proposed that each of the applications for approval and allocation submitted be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that each of the five applications for approval of the project and allocation of tax credits for 1997 be and the same are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development prior to December 2, 1996.
