SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED by the County Council of Prince

George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that Section 27-461(b)(1)(E) of the Zoning Ordinance of Prince George's County, Maryland, being also Subtitle 27 of the Prince George's County Code, is hereby repealed and reenacted with the following amendments:
