## RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

The Disposition of a Parcel of County-Owned Property

FOR the purpose of approving the determination of the County

Executive that a Parcel of County Owned property is not required for the public use of the County and is appropriate for disposition in accordance with the provisions of Section 2-111.1 of the Prince George's County Code.

WHEREAS, Parcel 25 found on Page 66 at Grid E-3 of the current tax map, was obtained by the County by deed on April 3, 1967 recorded among the Land Records of Prince George's County in Liber 3470, Folio 35; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-111.1 of the County Code, 1987 Edition, as amended, provides that the County Executive shall submit to the County Council, for its approval, by resolution, his determination that certain County-owned real property is not needed for the public use of the County and his plan for the disposition of the same; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has submitted to the County

Council his determination that the parcel of property will not be

required for public use of the County and his plan for disposition

of the property; therefore

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the determination of the County Executive that the property adjacent to Hill Road, being all of that property situate in the 18th Election District of Prince George's County, Maryland, and being described as Parcel 25 on Page 66 at Grid E-3 of the current tax map, and having an assessment value of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00), a fair market value of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000), is not required for the public use of the County, be and the same is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the plan of the County Executive to dispose of a Parcel of County-owned property in accordance with the provisions of Section 2-111.1 of the County Code be and the same is hereby approved.
