PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT

Date: 6-29-95

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0 (In favor: Council Members Estep, Del Giudice, Gourdine, Maloney and Russell).

This resolution amends the salary schedules by removing the extraordinary benefit for "involuntary separation." This legislation will accomplish the same result as CB-18-1995, but it will take effect immediately.

There should be a positive fiscal impact on the County, however, the number of "involuntary separations" cannot be predicted and an amount cannot be determined at this time.
