RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Spending Affordability Limits for the

Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission

For the purpose of establishing spending control limits on the Fiscal Year 2011 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission (WSSC).

WHEREAS, during the Fiscal Year 1994 Bi-County budget process the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils established a Bi-County Working Group to recommend changes that would control the growth of debt and maintain future rate increases at WSSC close to the level of inflation; and

WHEREAS, the Working Group's January 1994 Report recommended the establishment of a spending affordability process; and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council endorsed the entire Working Group's report through the adoption of CR-12-1994 and the Montgomery County Council endorsed part of the report's recommendations through Resolution #12-1558; and

WHEREAS, the Councils jointly endorsed in concept the January 1994 Working Group Report spending affordability process; and

WHEREAS, both Councils endorsed the utilization of the spending affordability process beginning with the formulation of the Fiscal Year 1996 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Spending Affordability Working Group, consisting of the staffs of the Montgomery and Prince George's County Councils and both County Executive's offices, make certain recommendations on the WSSC Fiscal Year 2011 Operating and Capital Budgets; and

1 WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council and the Montgomery Council have 2 reviewed the information compiled by the staff relating to spending control limits on the 3 percentage of water and sewer increase; new debt; debt service and operating expenditures; WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council recommends that WSSC, in conjunction 4 5 with its Fiscal Year 2011 Budget transmittal, identify priority items that would not be funded 6 within the approved Fiscal Year 2011 spending control limits. These items can be considered for 7 funding at the May 2010 Bi-County meeting; and 8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's 9 County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council hereby endorses the following 10 spending control limits for the Fiscal Year 2011 Water and Sewer Operating and Capital Budgets 11 of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission: 12 13 Water and Sewer Bill increase: Eight point zero percent (8.0%) New Water and Sewer Debt: 14 Two hundred and seventy three million, two 15 hundred and seventy nine thousand 16 dollars 17 (\$273,279,000) 18 Water and Sewer Debt Service: One hundred and seventy five million, 19 Eight hundred and three thousand 20 dollars 21 (\$175,803,000) 22 Water and Sewer Operating Five hundred and Forty million, six hundred 23 Fund Expenditures: and thirty two thousand dollars 24 (\$536,136,000) 25
