Committee Vote: Favorable 4-0 (In Favor: Councilmember's Exum, Knotts, Bland, and Turner)

This bill will amend certain sections of the County Code which will provide for a reduction in the surety bonds posted for urban road construction and rural road classifications on a prorated basis, depending on the value of the completed and approved work. (Section 23-116 (h) (5). Also, it will amend the provisions related to payment for fees for the extension of a valid road construction or storm water drain permits. The amended provisions of this legislation shall expire on April 15, 2011.

The Office of Law has reviewed this legislation and finds it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The enactment of CB-25-2009 will not have significant adverse fiscal impact on the County according to the Office of Audits and Investigation.

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BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation will provide for a reduction in the surety bonds posted for urban road classifications and rural road classifications, upon the request of the permittee, on a prorated basis, depending on the value of the completed and approved work. It will also amend provisions related to fees for the extension of valid road construction or storm drain permits. The provisions of this legislation shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect after April 15, 2011.
