**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning  
2 The Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Sectional Map Amendment–Approval  
3 For the purpose of approving, pursuant to the local zoning laws for that portion of the Maryland-  
4 Washington Regional District situated in Prince George’s County, Maryland, the Langley Park-  
5 College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Sectional Map Amendment (SMA), thereby setting forth  
6 and adopting detailed zoning proposals for the Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt-and  
7 Vicinity, generally comprised of properties located in an area north of Berwyn Road, east of 49th  
8 Avenue, south of Roanoke Place and Ruatan Street, and west of 5012 Berwyn Road (Tax  
9 Account 2287605); and include the commercially zoned properties within the designated  
10 boundary (Tax Accounts 2347466, 2385946, 2318996, 2311975, 2326247, 2349751, 2377224,  
11 2299774, 2286847, 2383461, 2395440, and 2349736).

12 WHEREAS, upon approval by the District Council, this SMA will amend portions of the  
13 Prince George’s County Zoning Map for portions of Planning Area 66 within the Langley Park-  
14 College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity; and

15 WHEREAS, on January 16, 2024, the County Council of Prince George’s County,  
16 Maryland, sitting as the District Council, pursuant to Sections 27-3502 and 3503 of the Zoning  
17 Ordinance, adopted CR-001-2024, thereby authorizing initiation of a Sectional Map Amendment  
18 concurrent with the initiation of the Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Minor  
19 Plan Amendment; and

1           WHEREAS, the boundaries of this Sectional Map Amendment are located within the  
2 Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity; and

3           WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 27-3502 and 3503 of the Zoning Ordinance, this  
4 Sectional Map Amendment was prepared and reviewed concurrently with the Langley Park-  
5 College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Minor Plan Amendment; and

6           WHEREAS, the District Council and the Prince George’s County Planning Board of The  
7 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission held a duly advertised joint public  
8 hearing on March 19, 2024; and

9           WHEREAS, the Planning Board held a work session on April 25, 2024, to review  
10 comments contained in the public hearing record and staff recommendations thereon; and

11           WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 27-3502(i)(5) of the Zoning Ordinance, the Planning  
12 Board adopted the concurrent Langley Park-College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Minor Plan  
13 Amendment, on April 25, 2024, and, pursuant to this Section and Section 27-3503(b)(4) of the  
14 Zoning Ordinance, adopted Resolution PGCPB No. 2024-28, endorsing the Langley Park-  
15 College Park-Greenbelt-and Vicinity Sectional Map Amendment, and recommending approval,  
16 to the District Council; and

17           WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 27-3502(i)(6) of the Zoning Ordinance, the Planning  
18 Board transmitted the Adopted Minor Plan Amendment, technical staff report, and Endorsed  
19 Sectional Map Amendment, with their respective recommendations as to same, to the District  
20 Council on May 1, 2024; and

21           WHEREAS, on May 28, 2024, the District Council held a public work session in  
22 accordance with the provisions set forth in the applicable zoning laws to consider the record of  
23 public hearing testimony and the Planning Board’s recommendations embodied in PGCPB No.  
24 2024-28; and

25           WHEREAS, upon discussion consideration and discussion by the District Council, the  
26 Committee voted favorably to direct staff to prepare a Resolution of Approval for the  
27 Amendment.

1           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
2 County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington  
3 Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Langley Park-College Park-  
4 Greenbelt-and Vicinity Sectional Map Amendment, as endorsed on April 25, 2024, by PGPCB  
5 No. 2024-28, be and the same and is hereby APPROVED.

6           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the planning staff is authorized to make appropriate  
7 textual, graphical, and map revisions to correct identified errors, reflect updated information and  
8 revisions, and incorporate the zoning map changes reflected in this Resolution.

9           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Sectional Map Amendment is an amendment to  
10 the official Zoning Map for the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's  
11 County. The zoning changes approved by this Resolution shall be depicted on the official Zoning  
12 Map of the County.

13           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution are severable. If any  
14 provision, sentence, clause, section, zone, zoning map, or part thereof is held illegal, invalid,  
15 unconstitutional, or unenforceable, such illegality, invalidity, unconstitutionality, or  
16 unenforceability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses,  
17 sections, zones, zoning maps, or parts hereof for their application to other zones, persons, or  
18 circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Resolution would have  
19 been adopted as if such illegal, invalid, unconstitutional, or unenforceable provision, sentence,  
20 clause, section, zone, zoning map, or part had not been included therein.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its  
2 adoption.
