For the purpose of	adopting the Prince George's County Five-Year Transit Vision Plan (TVP) as
the official docum	ent to guide the County's implementation and operation of County public
transportation serv	vices for the next five years.
WHEREAS,	the TVP identifies the County transit demands and needs as defined by those
areas which can su	apport bus services, but lack sufficient service; and
WHEREAS, the TVP identifies service improvements for Metrobus service, local bus	
services and paratransit service based on a comprehensive analysis of existing services,	
mobility needs, potential transit demand and prior studies; and	
WHEREAS, the TVP is a comprehensive five-year plan providing cost, revenue and	
funding projections to guide transit services through the Year 2030; and	
WHEREAS,	the base year of the plan is funded through the Maryland Department of
Transportation and the Washington Suburban Transit Commission Fund; and	
WHEREAS,	the Maryland Department of Transportation has funded the implementation of
new local bus services for the base year as recommended in the TVP; and	
WHEREAS, the TVP establishes public transportation goals and policies for operating bus	
service in the County and service standards for measuring these goals and policies; and	
WHEREAS,	the Department of Public Works and Transportation is designated as the
County agency responsible for implementation of the TVP.	
NOW, THE	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's

County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Five-Year Transit Vision Plan is adopted.
