SUBSTITUTE DRAFT 2 FOR DRAFT 1.

This resolution will allow the County to require that a person be licensed to engage in the business of competitive billing services since the County assesses a local energy tax. The resolution also mandates that competitive billing services will commence on July 1, 2000.

The Legislative Officer stated that the resolution in its present form provides for an impermissible delegation of legislative power to the executive branch of government. He recommends that, prior to adoption of this resolution by the Council, the County Executive

should define the proposed regulatory scheme as an attachment and that the resolution be amended to temporarily adopt or approve the attached regulatory program pending a more permanent enactment, by law, of the final licensing provisions.

The legislation was amended on page 2, line 5 to provide that the regulations be submitted to the Council sixty days prior to the proposed effective date.

There will be no negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-32-2000.
