For the purpose of prohibiting at the request of the National Football League the scalping of			
tickets to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events contingent upon a successful bid			
by the Washington,	D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008).		
WHEREAS, th	ne National Football League (the "League") owns, produces and controls the		
annual professional football championship game known as the "Super Bowl", the largest national			
annual sporting event held in this country; and National Football League Properties, LLC			
("NFLP" or, together with the League, the "NFL") owns, produces and controls the "NFL			
Experience," and along with other NFL Affiliates, owns, produces and controls certain other			
events associated with the Super Bowl ("Official Events"); and			
WHEREAS, FedExField (the "Stadium") is located at 1600 FedEx Way, Landover,			
Maryland 20785; an	nd		
WHEREAS, pursuant to the Bid Specifications for Super Bowl XLII (2008), the National			
Football League has requested the prohibition of the scalping of tickets to Super Bowl XLII			
(2008) and related C	Official Events.		
SECTION 1.	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince		
George's County, Maryland, that as requested by the NFL, and as part of the formal bid of the			
Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee with Prince George's County, Maryland to be

designated as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium

and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, the governing body of Prince

1. Upon designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland, and at all times thereafter, Prince George's County, Maryland agrees at the request of the National Football League to prohibit the sale or resale, barter, exchange or otherwise offer to sell or resell tickets for profit or more than the price stated on the ticket for admission to Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events from the sidewalk, street, or public space anywhere in Prince George's County, Maryland. A violation of this prohibition shall be deemed a civil violation pursuant to Section 1-123 of the Prince George's County Code, subject to a fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of adoption and that Section 1 of this Resolution shall take effect upon the date of receipt of a successful bid by the Washington, D.C. Super Bowl Host Committee for Super Bowl XLII (2008). In the event that the designation of Prince George's County, Maryland as the site for Super Bowl XLII (2008) and related Official Events, with the Stadium and related facilities located in Prince George's County, Maryland does not occur, the provisions of this Resolution shall be deemed null and void and of no further force and effect.
