BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT:

This resolution creates the Prince George’s County Infrastructure Implementation Working Group for the purpose of supporting the final recommendations of the Sewer Extension Needs for Unserved and Underserved Neighborhoods Bi-County Infrastructure Working Group. The Bi-County Infrastructure

Working Group recognized that there is a growing public health problem in unserved and underserved communities due to a lack of access to public water and sewer services. The Bi-County Infrastructure Working Group completed its work and presented a final report including recommendations to the Prince George's County Council on January 11, 2022. The Bi-County Infrastructure Working Group concluded that this is a complex problem that will take many years to address on an ongoing basis. This resolution will create a formal working group to facilitate implementation of the recommendations on an ongoing basis as the Bi-County Infrastructure Working Group recommended.
