A RESOLUTION	concerning
Designation of the	ne Mount Hermon Masonic Temple as a Prince George's County Historic Site
For the purpose of	f approving the designation of the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple
(Documented Pro	perty 68-010-95) as a Historic Site in Prince George's County, Maryland.
WHEREAS,	Section 29-120.01 of the Prince George's County Code provides a process for
the owner(s) of ar	historic property to petition the Prince George's County Historic Preservation
Commission for H	listoric Site designation; and
WHEREAS,	in accordance with the provisions of Section 29-120.01 of the Prince George's
County Code, Kay	leigh Kulp filed a petition with the Historic Preservation Commission for
designation of the	property described below, with the authorization of the property owner, One
Seven Nine Temp	le Holding Corporation; and
WHEREAS,	after proper posting and notice was given as required by law, the Prince
George's County Historic Preservation Commission held a public hearing on July 23, 2024, on	
the subject petitio	n; and
WHEREAS,	the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple, located at 4207 Gallatin Street,
Hyattsville, was built circa 1893 and is significant as a unique example of Romanesque Revival	
architecture in the	Hyattsville National Register Historic District; and
WHEREAS, the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple was built for and used by the Mount	
Hermon Lodge, a local Masonic chapter, and over the course of its long history has served as a	

meeting and function space for many organizations and community groups and is an

architectural landmark within Hyattsville; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Commission recommended that the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple (Documented Property 68-010-95), and its 0.145-acre Environmental Setting (Lot 11, Block A, "Wine & Johnson's 2nd Addition to Hyattsville, MD") be designated as a Historic Site on the basis of certain historic site designation criteria stated in County Code Section 29-104(a), namely, criteria (1)(A)(iii), (1)(A)(iv), (2)(A)(i), and (2)(A)(v); and

WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the District Council, held a joint public hearing on the significance of this property with the Prince George's County Planning Board on September 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the record of the hearing was left open until 5:00 p.m. on September 25, 2024, and no additional testimony was received; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2024, the Prince George's County Planning Board voted unanimously to recommend that the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple be designated as a Prince George's County Historic Site; and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2024, in accordance with provisions of local law, the District Council convened as the Committee of the Whole to review the transcript analysis and Planning Board recommendation as to the proposed designation and favorably voted to direct the staff to prepare a Resolution of Approval as to the proposed Historic Site Designation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that that the Mount Hermon Masonic Temple (Documented Property 68-010-95) and its 0.145-acre Environmental Setting (Lot 11, Block A, "Wine & Johnson's 2nd Addition to Hyattsville, MD") is hereby designated as a Prince George's County Historic Site.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council be directed to mail copies of this Resolution to the Prince George's County Historic Preservation Commission, the Prince George's County Planning Board, and to the property owner, Michael Garner (One Seven Nine Temple Holding Corporation), and petitioner, Kayleigh Kulp.
