**RESOLUTION**

1 A RESOLUTION concerning

2 Contract Approvals

3 For the purpose of approving a multi-year contract to procure maintenance services for the  
4 County’s Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management’s communication  
5 equipment and supporting software.

6 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter of Prince George’s County, Maryland  
7 the County Council must approve, by resolution, all multi-year contracts exceeding an aggregate  
8 of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00); and

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 819 of the Charter for Prince Georges County, Maryland  
10 no agency of the County Government shall, during any fiscal year, expend any money or incur  
11 any liability in excess of the amounts appropriated and no such payment shall be made, nor any  
12 obligation or liability incurred, except for purchase in an amount to be fixed by legislative act;  
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Motorola Solution, Inc  
15 (Contractor) for the purposes of ensuring continuing maintenance of legacy software, hardware,  
16 licenses for radio communications, computer aided software, mobile data, 911 Center phone  
17 equipment (Plant Vesta) records management software and Next Generation 9-1-1; and

18 WHEREAS, the contract between Prince George’s County, Maryland and Contractor, will  
19 be conducted pursuant to the terms and conditions contained herein as Attachment A.

1 WHEREAS, County Code Section 10A-114(a)(1)(F) provides that the Purchasing Agent is  
2 authorized to award a contract by non-competitive negotiation when only one product will meet  
3 the technical performance requirements for the procurement nature; and

4 WHEREAS, the County Purchasing Agent has determined that the Contractor is the only  
5 practical source for continuing the provision of such support and maintenance services and it is  
6 in the County's best interest to continue to utilize the Contractor for the support and maintenance  
7 of ASTRO 25 Radio Communication System, 911 Center, and related technology including  
8 CAD, Mobile Data, and Plant Vesta (911 Phone Equipment).

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's  
10 County, Maryland, that the agreement as described in Attachment A and pursuant to Section 819  
11 of the Prince George's County Charter be and the same is hereby APPROVED.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
13 any modifications, adjustment, correction, or any other changes as may be necessary to finalize  
14 the contract in any manner the County Executive may deem necessary or proper but not altering  
15 its substance.
