





- 1 - Director of the Juvenile Services Agency, Region VII or designee
- 1 - Superintendent of the Prince George's County Public Schools or designee
- 1 - Representative appointed by the Secretary of the State Dept. of Human Resources
- 1 - Representative appointed by the County Executive
- 8 - Citizens of the county appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the Council

The legislation removes the requirement that at least 2 citizen representatives must come from the geographic area impacted by the project. Ms. Dorothy Bailey, Director for the Commission for Families was present for the worksession. The Commission has submitted a new family preservation proposal which if accepted will expand the project County-wide. The Commission felt it necessary to include citizen representatives from other areas of the County if the project is expanded.

The Office of Law has reviewed the legislation and found it to be in proper form.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**

This bill will expand the membership of the Commission for Families Governing Board. Currently, the thirteen member board has six citizen members. This bill will increase the number of voting, citizen members to fifteen of which eight will be citizen members.
