Strategy Areas (ESAs); Stream Buffer Widths; Stream, Wetland, and Water Quality Protection and Stormwater Management; Stream Buffer Requirements Summary; Tree Canopy Cover (TCC); 2023 Tree Canopy Assessment; Tree Canopy Applicability; Tree Canopy Coverage Requirements; Tree Canopy Cover Ordinance Summary; Thresholds and Replacement Requirements; Woodland Conservation and Afforestation Thresholds Requirements; Summary of Thresholds and Replacement Requirements; Alternative Credits and Woodland Conservation Banking; Summary of Alternative Credits; New State FCA Definitions in 2021; Natural Resources Qualified Conservation; Forest Mitigation Banking Priority Retention Areas; Forest Mitigation Banking Forest Mitigation Banking Options; Summary of Woodland Conservation Banking; Exemptions; Public Notice and Comments/Judicial Review; Notice; Priority Retention Areas; Notice Requirement for ALL Tree Conservation Plans (TCPs); Public Comments; Judicial Review; Summary of Public Notice and Comments / Judicial Review; Written Findings and Statements of Justification; Statements of Justification (SOJs); Grandfathering; Updates to the Woodland Conservation Ordinance; Grandfathering Provisions; Minor and Major Revisions; and Next Steps.
