RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

General Schedule Employees

For the purpose of amending the Salary Plan of the County to reflect a certain modification for General Schedule employees.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 903 of Article IX of the Prince George's County Charter and Section 16-125(a) of the Prince George's County Code, amendments to the County's Salary Plan are to be submitted to the County Council in resolution form; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended that the Salary Plan be amended to reflect a certain modification for General Schedule employees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the County Council hereby approves the amendment to Salary Schedule G, Schedule of Pay Grades - General Schedule Employees, submitted and recommended by the County Executive on June 13, 1995, amending the Salary Schedule approved and adopted by CR-56-1994 on June 21, 1994, adding a new Subsection II C to read as follows:

II. MERIT INCREASES FOR FISCAL YEARS 1994 [AND], 1995, AND 1996.

C. FY 1996

Effective July 1, 1995, merit increases for fiscal year 1996 shall be suspended for employees covered by Salary Schedule G.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all other provisions of the Salary Schedule approved and adopted by CR-56-1994 remain unchanged.
