A RESOLUTION	N concerning	
	Postponement of Demolition of the Marlton Gazebo	
For the purpose of postponing the scheduled demolition of the Marlton Gazebo by the		
Department of Public Works and Transportation during the week of July 8, 2002.		
WHEREAS, the Marlton Community is the first planned community in Prince George's		
County established in the 1960s; and		
WHEREAS, the Marlton Community established various types of housing for Prince		
George's County residents; and		
WHEREAS, the Gazebo located at the entrance of the Marlton Community at the		
intersection of North Marlton Avenue and U.S. Route 301 was constructed in the early 1960s on		
the County's right-of-way as a symbol of the Marlton Community; and		
WHEREAS, this community assumed the responsibility for the maintenance and upkeep of		
the common entrance area shared by the citizens and visitors alike; and		
WHEREAS, during the course of a decade the structure has deteriorated to the point of		
disrepair and requires extensive renovation; and		
WHEREAS, the Citizens Association of Marlton ("CAM") submitted a proposal for		
financial assistance through the Prince George's County Community Block Grant Program; and		
WHEREAS, it was determined in accordance with the Community Development Block		
Grant guidelines, the Marlton Gazebo structure does not meet the criteria for funding; and		
WHEREAS, the Citizens Association of Marlton recommended an alternative proposal to		
the Department of	of Public Works and Transportation to satisfy the County and the Marlton	

Community to restore the Gazebo to a safe and attractive manner; and

WHEREAS, during the past few months the Department of Public Works and Transportation has explored several alternatives in an effort to assist the community with saving this landmark; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Transportation cost estimates for construction ranges from \$70,000 for repairs to \$94,000 for total replacement of the structure, plus engineering design costs of \$32,000 to \$35,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the scheduled demolition of the Marlton Gazebo be postponed indefinitely allowing concerned parties to explore additional alternatives for the reconstruction or refurbishment, funding and perpetual maintenance of the Gazebo.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council be directed to expedite delivery of this Resolution upon adoption to the Director of Public Works and Transportation.
