PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT Date: 10/21/99

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Council Members Wilson, Hendershot, Maloney, Russell and Scott).

This resolution will amend the Salary Plan in Salary Schedule M for Paramedics in the Fire/EMS Department represented by the International Association of Fire Fighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619, and reflects modifications of the two year collective bargaining agreement.

The highlights of the Salary Plan and the fiscal impact are contained in CB-77-1999.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT
