PUBLIC SAFETY & FISCAL MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE REPORT: Date: 10/4/01

Committee Vote: Favorable, 5-0, (In favor: Councilmembers Bailey, Scott, Estepp, Maloney and Shapiro).

This resolution will amend the Fiscal Year 2002 Revenue Authority Operating Budget and the Fiscal Year 2002-2007 Revenue Authority Capital Improvement Program to include transportation projects resulting from the merger which will be effective January 1, 2002.

The projects which are transferred to the Revenue Authority Capital Improvement Program (CIP) as a result of the termination of the Parking Authority include the College Park/Riverdale TDOZ, the New Carrollton Parking District, Parking Revitalization, Prince George's Plaza TDOZ and West Hyattsville TDOZ projects.

The Office of Law has reviewed the resolution and find it to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

There should not be any negative fiscal impact on the County as a result of adopting CR-49-2001.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT**(Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)**

This resolution provides comments on the amendment of the Fiscal Year 2001-2002 Operating Budget of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County and amends the Fiscal Year 2002-2007 Capital Improvement Program of the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County to include the College Park/Riverdale TDOZ, the New Carrollton Parking District, Parking Revitalization, Prince George's Plaza TDOZ Parking, and the West Hyattsville TDOZ projects resulting from the termination of the Parking Authority of Prince George's County and transfer by Prince George's County, Maryland to the Revenue Authority of Prince George's County title to all property of the Parking Authority of Prince George's County and all obligations and assets of the Parking Authority of Prince George's County.
