("HHGREGG") FROM THE MARYLAND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE FUND ("MEDAF") AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, MARYLAND (THE "COUNTY") for the purpose of endorsing a loan not to exceed \$80,000 to hhgregg from MEDAF and authorizing a loan by the County to hhgregg not to exceed \$50,000 for eligible project costs associated with leasing a facility in the County and capital expenditures.
