	RESOLUTION

## A RESOLUTION concerning

Prince George's County Income Tax Rate

For the purpose of increasing the County income tax rate to 3.20% of the State taxable income.

WHEREAS, Section 10-106(a)(1) of the Tax-General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that each county shall set, by ordinance or resolution, a county income tax equal to at least 1% but not more than 3.20% of an individual's Maryland taxable income for a taxable year beginning after December 31, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-106(a)(2) of the Tax-General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that a county income tax rate continues until the county changes the rate by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-106(a)(3) of the Tax-General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that a county may not increase its county income tax rate above 2.6% until after the county has held a public hearing on the proposed act, ordinance, or resolution to increase the rate and requires the county to publish at least once each week for 2 successive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the county notice of the public hearing and a fair summary of the proposed act, ordinance, or resolution to increase the county income tax rate above 2.6%; and

WHEREAS, SECTION 6 of Chapter 10 of the Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland (CB-35-2006) reduced the County income tax rate from 3.20 percent to 3.1 percent for calendar years beginning January 1, 2007; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-106(b) of the Tax-General Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland provides that if a county changes its county income tax rate, the county shall increase

or decrease the rate in increments of one one-hundredth of a percentage point, effective on January 1 of the year that the county designates, and shall give the Comptroller notice of the rate change and the effective date of the rate change on or before July 1 prior to its effective date; and

WHEREAS, the County Council duly advertised and conducted a public hearing on the proposal of the County Executive to increase the County income tax from 3.10% to 3.20%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that in consideration of, and based upon the comments provided by persons who testified at the public hearing conducted by the Council the County income tax rate shall be increased to 3.20% for calendar years beginning January 1, 2009.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Council shall deliver a copy of this resolution to the State Comptroller on or before July 1, 2008.
