### REPORT:

Committee Vote: Forward with No Recommendation 4-0 (In favor: Chair Harrison, Council Members Oriadha, Hawkins, and Watson; Absent: Council Member Blegay).

The Education and Workforce Development Committee convened on March 25, 2025, to consider the appointment of Ms. Aimee Olivo to fill a vacancy in the Board of Education's District 4 seat. The nomination was transferred by the Acting County Executive to the County Council on February 28, 2025.

The Board of Education is the governing body of Prince George's County Public Schools, setting policy and overseeing operations.

Miriam Brewer, the County Executive's Appointments Liaison, introduced Ms. Olivo, a resident of Cheverly. Ms. Brewer and Ms. Olivo provided a statement of qualifications and discussed her purpose for serving on the Board.

Council Members asked Ms. Olivo questions relating to her expertise and her expected role within the Board.

On March 24, 2025, the Education and Workforce Development Committee voted to move the appointment forward to the Council with no recommendation: 4-0.
