	Financial Literacy Task Force					
For the purpose of establishing the Financial Literacy Task Force to explore and facilitate the						
financial literacy of the residents and citizens of Prince George's County.						
WHEREAS, President Barack Obama proclaimed April 2011 as National Financial						
Literacy Month; and						
WHEREAS, President Barack Obama indicates Americans' ability to build a secure future						
for themselves and their families requires the navigation of an increasing complex financial						
system; and						
WHEREAS	S, as our Country recovers from the worst economic crisis in generations, it is					
more important t	to be knowledgeable about the consequences of financial decisions; and					
WHEREAS, the financial stability and prosperity of our Country and County will						
ultimately depend on the willingness of individuals to empower themselves and families with						
financial knowledge; and						
WHEREAS	S, the President's Advisory Council on Financial Literacy defines personal					
financial literacy as "the ability to use knowledge and skills to manage financial resources						
effectively for a lifetime of financial well-being"; and						
WHEREAS, Prince George's County supports the national effort to improve the						
understanding of financial principles and practices of residents and citizens; and						
WHEREAS, the Prince George's County Council desires to further examine financial						
education and its impact on residents and citizens, and consider appropriate recommendations for						
improvements related thereto; and

WHEREAS, Section 506 of the Charter provides that the Council may appoint, for designated periods, one or more temporary boards of citizens of the County who shall assist in the consideration of County policies and programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Financial Literacy Task Force is hereby established to study, research, determine and recommend to the County Council ways in which residents and citizens can make informed decisions about personal finances, based on an understanding of the principles of credit, debt, savings and investments, depository institutions, interest, budgeting, and explore establishment of a Financial Literacy Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Financial Literacy Task Force shall be composed of nine (9) members as follows:

- 1. The Chairman of the County Council or the Chairman's representative, who shall serve as the Chair of the Task Force;
 - The County Executive or the County Executive's representative;
 - A representative from the Prince George's County Public Schools;
 - 4. A representative from the Prince George's Community College;
- Two (2) representatives with extensive knowledge of financial institutions, personal finance and financial literacy programs who represent the diverse cultures of Prince George's County;
 - One (1) representative from a nonprofit organization; 6.
- One (1) representative from a Prince George's County real estate professional association; and
 - 8. One (1) citizen of the County selected by the Chairman of the County Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Financial Literacy Task Force shall present its evaluation and recommendations to the County Council on or before November 1, 2011.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council Administrator shall assign appropriate technical and administrative support staff to assist the Financial Literacy Task Force in its work.
