BACKGROUND INFORMATION/FISCAL IMPACT (Includes reason for proposal, as well as any unique statutory requirements)

This bill proposes to amend Section 309 of the Charter of Prince George's County to provide for the election of a Council Member in the event of a vacancy which occurs more than ninety days prior to a primary or general election. The amendment would require the members of the Council at the time of the vacancy to schedule a special election within 90 days, but not less than 30 days, of the vacancy to fill the vacancy. If a vacancy occurs within 90 days of the primary or general election, the Council seat shall remain vacant until the election.
