WHEREAS	, Title XII of Division A of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of	
2009, Pub. L. No	. 111-5, 123 Stat. 115, 221-222 (2009) (hereinafter "Title XII of the Recovery	
Act"), appropriat	ed \$1.5 billion for a Homelessness Prevention Fund; and	
WHEREAS	, the program established under Title XII of the Recovery Act is commonly	
referred to as the	Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) for	
homelessness pre	evention assistance to households who would otherwise become homeless and to	
provide assistanc	e to rapidly re-house persons who are homeless as defined under section 103 of	
the McKinney-V	ento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11302) (the "Act"); and	
WHEREAS	, Title XII of the Recovery Act provides that the HPRP funding shall be	
allocated to grantees eligible under the Emergency Shelter Grant program, pursuant to the		
formula authorize	ed by section 413 of the Act; and	
WHEREAS	, the County has been allocated \$2,512,242 in HPRP funding; and	
WHEREAS, in order to receive its allocation, the County is required by HUD Notice,		
Docket No. FR-5	307-N-01 (March 19, 2009), to submit by May 18, 2009, an HPRP substantial	
amendment to the	e County's "Annual Action Plan: FY 2009," a draft copy of which is attached	
hereto and incorporated herein as the "Substantial Amendment to the Consolidated Plan 2008		

Action Plan for the Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP)," which

has the effect of amending the County's "Annual Action Plan: FY 2009"; and

WHEREAS, the HPRP substantial amendment allows the Prince George's County Department of Housing and Community Development to use \$2,512,242 in HPRP funds for eligible costs associated with financial assistance, housing relocation and stabilization services, data collection and evaluation, and administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County that the HPRP substantial amendment, a copy of which shall be marked for identification by the Clerk of the County Council and maintained as a permanent record, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive or his designee is hereby authorized to submit the HPRP substantial amendment to the U.S. Department of Housing and Community Development ("HUD"), to act as necessary in connection with the submission, and to provide such additional information to HUD as may be required.
